### LAND SWINDLES EXPOSED IN HART'S FILM, "BREED OF MEN"

Favorite Aircraft Star Seen As the Bad Man in Picture of Unusual Beauty.

### NOTICE TO PROPERTY OWNERS OF FOURTH STREET.
