The spring salmon season at Astoria closed Monday, and the pack will be approximately 20 per cent under that of the spring season of 1918 which was upwards of 600,000 cases.

Paving of eight blocks of the main streets of Helix was contracted for Saturday with J. A. Gudgel, a contractor of Kallispel, Montana. The contract was let for \$18,742.20 and the work is to begin September 1. The paving will be of concrete and be the first ever laid in Helix.

N. O. Baker, formerly examiner in the farm division of the United States employment service, has succeeded G. A. Nelson as assistant employment agent for the Southern Pacific and O. W. R. & N. systems. Nelson has given up his work for the railroads to engage in private employment work.
