While cutting wood on his homestead 12 miles north of Prineville, R. H. Kincaid, age 32, was struck by a rolling log and instantly killed, Monday.

Thirty miles of grading on the Eastern Oregon highway will be contracted for next Tuesday at the September meeting of the State Highway Commission. The work takes in Sherman county and about half of Gilliam county, as far as Blalock. Several other matters of interest to Eastern Oregon highways will be settled at the time.
