

### Cadillacs Carry Noted Party Over. Western Mountains

In company with former heads of the Aircraft Production Board, Capt. Wright recently completed a vacation through the western wonderland of America.

Three stalwart Cadillac touring cars—the Mojave, Navajo and Apache, and another automobile furnished transportation for the distinguished party. In addition to Capt. Wright were Colonel Sidney Walden, automobile consulting engineer, Col. E. A. Deeds of DeLoe fame and son Charles, Col. M. F. Davis of the regular Army; also Lieut. H. H. Emerson, Gordon Wreathmacher, J. T. Bata, Harry Marchant and George Brantley.

Henry Ford's car, the Mojave, was driven through from Detroit to Denver in three days to meet him, but fatal complications kept him in Detroit.

Col. Walden led the modern caravan 2,200 miles across mountains and desert from Denver to Los Angeles.

The cars travelled 2,200 miles from Denver to Los Angeles. The route led directly through the Rockies, via Pike's Peak Ocean to Ocean Highway to Salt Lake, across Nevada to Reno, then up to the Sierra to Lake Tahoe, over the Tioga Pass into the Yosemite and back to San Francisco. Leaving the Golden Gate the trail led down the coast to Los Angeles.

The party was comprised largely of Easterners. They pitched camp each night and travelled by day. Never before had the grandeur and beauty of their own country been paraded before their eyes as it was on this eventful trip through deserts and mountains.

There were 500 miles of scenery that was awe inspiring. California was entered through the Mt. Carson Canyon, and the travellers pitched camp for the night on the placid shore of Lake Tahoe.

The men all brought back words of praise for the western roads, and road builders. In the party were easterners who did not know the Great West. But as one of them expressed it, "the trip made in three wonderful motor cars will never be forgotten."

### Original "Lone Tree."

There was an immense cottonwood, four feet thick and very tall, which stood in Nebraska almost in the center of the continent, half way between New York and San Francisco, which was within one mile of that center. Under its branches rested thousands of 40-erger route to the Eldorado of the Pacific coast. It was the best known camping ground on the old California trail. From 1849, when the gold seekers rushed across the great plains down to the completion of the Union Pacific railway, the great tree was a landmark to the wagon trains going west.

After the railway was completed there was no further use for the old tree and it eventually rotted away and died. In 1919 a monument was erected on the spot that the tree had occupied. It represents the trunk of a giant cottonwood and bears this inscription: "On this spot stood the original Lone Tree on the old California trail."

### Australian Water Holes.

A curious form of water hole is found in the deserts of western Australia, dry by day but yielding an abundant supply of water by night. The flow of water is produced by wind lifting and sounds of rushing air. On examining one it was found that the water supply occurred in a long narrow trench, at the bottom of which was a thin plate of gum, separated by a cavity from the main rock mass beneath. Apparently the heat of the day causes this plate to expand in the form of a depression in which the water retreats. When it cools and contracts at night it forces first air and then water back into the trench.

### How to Make Money Go.

By keeping the needles firmly pressed against the coin it will be held with sufficient firmness. 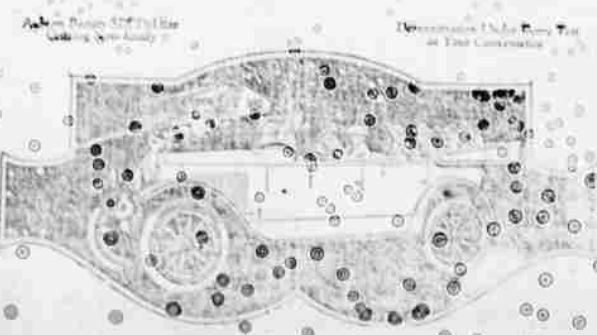
