From the fire department, no fires for the week. The fire chief has gone to Portland to attend the state convention of firemen.

From the police department, fourteen arrests for the week. 3 for the state, 1 for selling liquor, 1 for drunkenness, 1 for traffic violations, 1 for loitering. Fines collected \$50. Pound fees, \$12.00.

From the street department, the usual routine work and repair of walks and macadam streets.

From the water department, repair of leaks in the mains, both in the city and on the Beaver creek pipe line. The water superintendent and repair men went over the entire Beaver creek line as far as the phone box on Whiskey saddle and repaired all leaks. Seven leaks in all were found and the line was found in fairly good condition. There were a few places where the pipe was exposed and one or two joints of pipe in rather bad condition but made from this the line appeared to be functioning properly. A force of men has been employed at the intake digging a trench for the proposed new dam. Red rock was found across the stream but so far we have been unable to locate any ledge of rock on the west side to which the dam can be anchored. Mr. Kelley has been written in regard to the matter. We are also having lumber hauled for the dam. The Beaver creek telephone line was at

so damaged and repaired and is now in good condition. Arrangements were made with the owners of the line to keep same in repair between stations for the use of the line. The commission appointed to look up possible water supplies, visited Looking Glass creek and report that it is possible to get water from this stream and an ample supply to the city would probably require 10 miles of pipe. Other prospects are awaiting Kelley's return. Respectfully submitted,

State News

Both of Hood River's banking institutions have added bond departments to their service. With a wave of prosperity prevailing among orchardists, unusually heavy funds are available for investment, and the banks will handle high-class securities.

W. H. Weber, Chicago, capitalist, owner of the East Hood River fruit company's tracts at Mosier, declares that the crop of the district will exceed in tonnage that of any former year. Mr. Weber says the recent rains have been of incalculable value to orchardists, since they will greatly increase the size of the fruit. Mosier quality, according to the Chicago man was never better than on this season.

A total of \$2,082,000 was paid to residents of Oregon last year by life insurance companies.

Fat shipments of cattle are fast coming in from various parts of central Oregon for transfer over the Portland railroad. Six cars of fat-tender beef were included in a shipment for the Portland market Saturday. Fourteen cars were shipped to the Omaha markets Sunday by Wheeler county cattlemen.

When two prisoners of the state penitentiary were released on parole at 4 o'clock Monday afternoon the population of the prison dropped to 241, the lowest in more than 10 years.
