### SCRAMBLE FOR SUGAR IN PARISIAN STREETS

(Correspondence of The Associated Press.)  
PARIS, Aug. 22.—A truck driver was unloading a load of heavy sacks at a restaurant in one of the boulevards yesterday when one of them fell and its contents were spread over the sidewalk. A crowd gathered. One of the young men put his finger and

traced the white powder. "Great heavens! he shouted, "it is sugar."  
Then the pillage began. Newspapers, handkerchiefs and women's handbags served as receptacles for the precious white. In a few minutes there remained of that bag of sugar nothing but a white spot on the sidewalk around which congregated little dogs.

Every one is allowed two pounds of sugar per month in France upon production of his sugar card. The correspondent has produced his card about a dozen times since the beginning of the month, but he has not yet been able to obtain his August quota.

### BOLSHEVIKI BELIEVED TO BE ISOLATED

(Correspondence of The Associated Press.)  
LONDON, Aug. 21.—The international agents who are watching the Bolsheviks believe they have now isolated them from their world, that they are no longer a threat to the spread of their dangerous propaganda.  
Direct communication between the Bolsheviks and their agents abroad is being rendered increasingly difficult.

Four months have elapsed since the last direct communication from the Bolshevik leaders in Russia reached their fellows here.  
A Swede brought \$20,000 here recently for Bolshevik purposes. Five minutes after he delivered the money to an agent in London he was in custody. A Scotland Yard man was close to him during the whole of his journey to England.

### A Three-Ton Milk Bottle and What It Means

One cow, properly fed and cared for should give milk enough in one year to fill a bottle 4 and 1/2 feet wide and 3 feet high, with a capacity of 5,000 pounds.  
The kind of cow that will do this, and the amount and kind of feed that will enable her to, are to be the features in the U. S. exhibit at the National Dairy Show in Chicago, October 6 to 12.

Bessy and her calf will be there, staged in a little farm scene. The fodder rack and the hay stack holding the proper amount of dry forage for one year will occupy part of the exhibit. A miniature silo, containing the silage for the year's feeding, will also be shown. A part of the inclosure will be added to demonstrate the area of pasturage necessary to maintain the cow, and to crown all will be the giant milk bottle described above, which is to prove to the most sceptical how the well-tended cow pays for her keep.  
The amounts of dairy products represented as the result of the feeding are actual average obtained by the U. S. Dairy Division in a series of practical tests made on the dairy farms of northern Indiana.

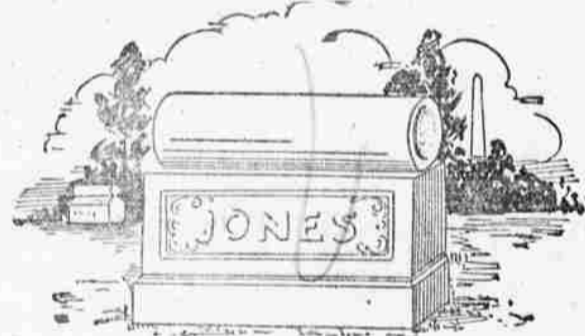
