The American Legion entered the issue here. The meeting closed with a general feeling that every man was a committee of one piece, to do his share in making the campaign a success and settle for all time the question of good roads in Union county. The matter of safe guarding the tax payer against dishonest or incompetent contractors came up for discussion and the following resolution was submitted and adopted and was unanimously signed by those present.

Resolved, By the undersigned men of Union county, that the time has come when attention must be paid to road construction in order to have the advanced improvements and in order to keep this county in the front rank which she has always held; and be it further

Resolved, That we have taken a deep personal interest in the bonding campaign which is now before us believing that it is the only proper way to build permanent highways, and we pledge to the taxpaying public of Union county that we will continue to act as a committee to look after the highway undertakings in Union county if this bond issue carries and to see that no construction company shall fail to give a dollar's worth of pavement for every dollar expended.

The resolution will be circulated throughout the county and when completed will be published again with all the complete list of signatures.

DESTRUCTION BY RATS REACHES LARGE AMOUNT

LONDON, (Correspondence of The Associated Press)—The war on rats, which was suspended while the other war was in progress, is being renewed by the Ministry of Agriculture which estimates that property to the value of \$250,000,000 is destroyed in the United Kingdom every year by rats.

The chief rat inspector of the

Board of Agriculture estimates that each rat destroys property to the value of about \$5 every year, while an official of the British Medical Association lays the spread of many deadly diseases, including trench fever, to rats.

Already precautions have been taken at the London docks which will prevent rats from landing from ships and which, if they do land, speedily ends in their death.
