DEPORTATION OF GERMANS FROM TONGA

Correspondence of the Associated Press. SYDNEY, Australia, Sept. 9.—Anti-British demonstrations and actions by Germans in the little Pacific kingdom of Tonga have aroused a feeling that all the Germans in the group should be deported. Recently the British representatives at Vavau were insulted and assaulted by a German, and an appeal to the local police for redress was futile. Supplying liquor to the natives and advancing credit to them the Germans, it is said, have won the support of most of the native chiefs. The British in Vavau have petitioned the New Zealand government for the deportation of the German who assaulted their representative, and of all other Germans in the group.

Cross Organization is Indispensable.

During the influenza epidemic, Red action and cooperation saved thousands lives, because the Red was fully organized in every county in the United States, and a possible recurrence of influenza this winter and against a danger epidemic in the future, could universal membership in the Cross is essential. Red Cross Peace Program Calls for Universal Support and Cooperation. The American Red Cross is still an agency organization. It must be so that there is such a thing as continuing disaster: 300,000 babies a year die of age die every year because of ignorance; thousands of persons die unnecessarily in childhood; it is still possible for an epidemic like the influenza to take a toll in a compass of a few weeks five times greater than the losses of our war in a year and a half of war; hundreds of thousands of people in every part of the world die in the United States.
