and Roumania to Galatz, and thence to Odessa. General Denikine, the anti-Bolshevik commander of the Cossack army, had captured the city before Captain McGuire arrived.

The captain found the Polish women living in conditions much resembling those of a town in northern France after an attack preceded by heavy artillery preparation. The Bolsheviks had destroyed whole blocks of houses, first rifling them with amazing thoroughness. Terrorist commissions and executed 5000 persons during the two months of occupation. Eventually the American was able to get his charges out of the city and back through Roumania and the Ukraine.

Captain McGuire comes from Tulsa, Oklahoma. A volunteer in the French army, he enlisted in the American army in France and was decorated with the distinguished service cross. He is only 22 years of age.

Mountain Climbing Exact Toll in Lives

GENEVA, Oct. 2.—Mountain climbing brought an unusually heavy crop of accidents this season. One of the most sensational occurred on the Piz Col a few days ago when two women slipped and fell into a crevasse 100 feet deep. Their male companion, unable to help, rushed for guides and after seven hours' imprisonment, the women were extricated, one dead and the other unconscious.

On the same day three young couples had just reached the summit of Lulin Peak, above Saitan, when a girl 21 years old collapsed and fell 500 feet. After an all-night search guides found her body and carried it with great difficulty to the village of Martigny.

A climber named Durisch died at St. Moritz after a fall on Mount Rosatch.

traveling position. Her industries can assume with little outside help. With a strong government that country should survive and prosper. Her danger seems to lie in probable racial antagonisms with resulting political complications.

Little Hope for Hungary.
As for Hungary, few people here believe it will survive as an independent country. Eventual union with Roumania seems now inevitable, either with its own king as vassal, or simply as part of the empire.

The Roumanians were quick to see the powerlessness of the allies and simply disregarded the communications from Paris. The so-called inter-allied military mission, unbacked by anything real, is a farce. The other day a letter came to the Roumanian commander by this mission, written in English, and he handed it back with the remark to communicate with him.

fact, there are any number of royal candidates in the offing waiting to see what will happen.

"As for Austria, every province and every district is a separate government by itself, acting independently and often in defiance of the Vienna government, which is actually controlled, as far as any control goes, by these workmen and soldiers' councils. Neither the Christian Socialists, nor the Social Democrats have a majority in the assembly, so that the All German party with its membership of about 39 has the balance of power and throws its vote to suit its own ends. There must be terrible suffering this winter. The country will be practically without fuel, and it is a rigorous winter climate. Food already is very scarce and poor and daily increases in price. The hospitals are still without supplies, the death rate is high, and the streets literally filled with beggar men, women and children. Highway robbery is prevalent, smuggling rampant and there are signs of revolution unless conditions quickly mend.

People Want Monarchy.
"There too, the body of the people seem to want a monarchy. They have had enough of republicanism. Well-informed people say a coup d'etat is not impossible. It would not take much to place a king back if there were a strong man with quality of leadership. In any event the reactionary element

is strong and growing stronger in the absence of leadership, in the present government.

"The Austrians are hopeless regarding their future and see only a union with Italy or Czecho-Slovakia if they are to survive. The country is bankrupt, stripped of its resources by the peace settlement and the people are too worn out to fight. In spite of the treaty there is a feeling that some way will be tried to bring about union with Germany."

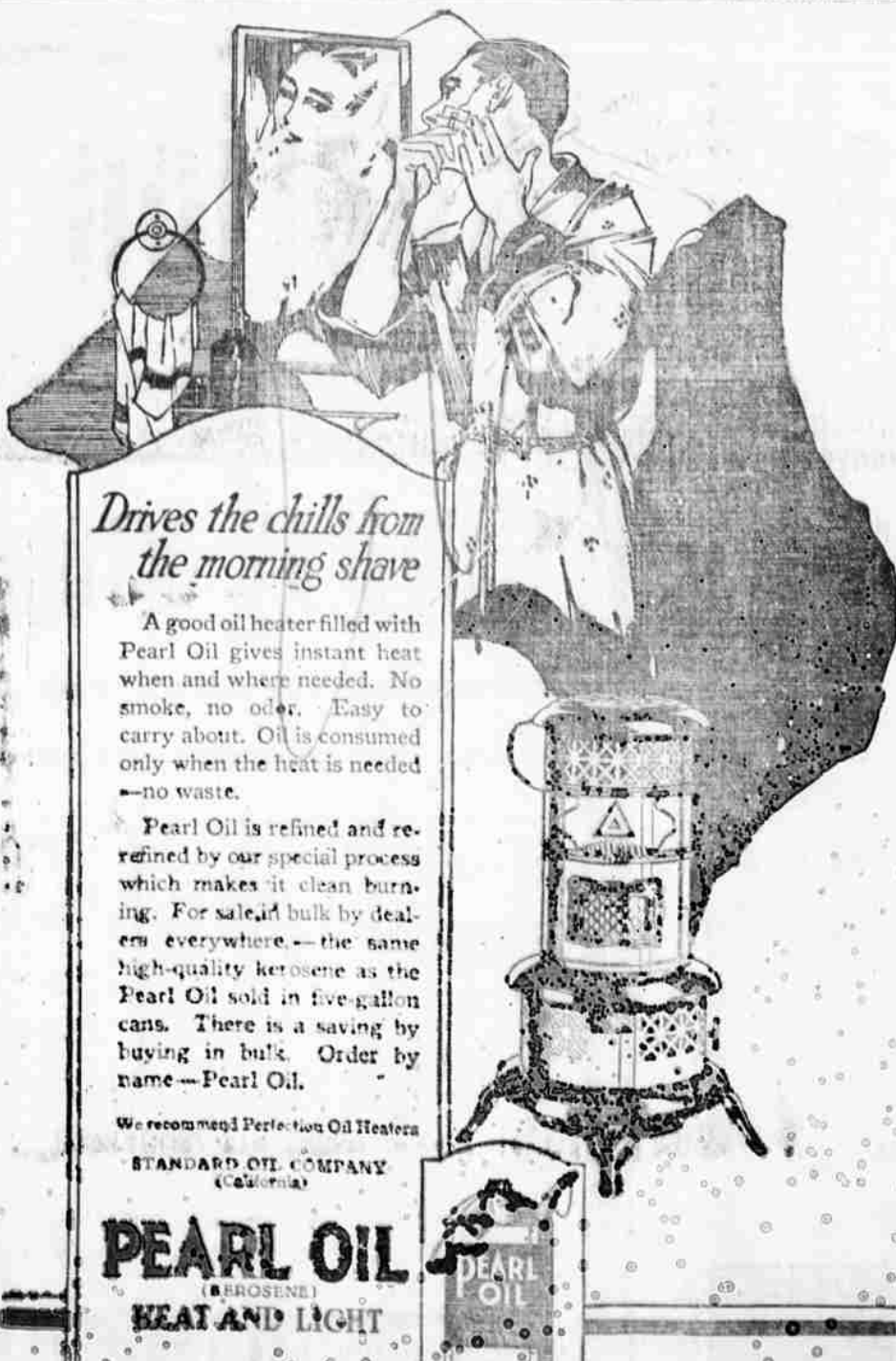

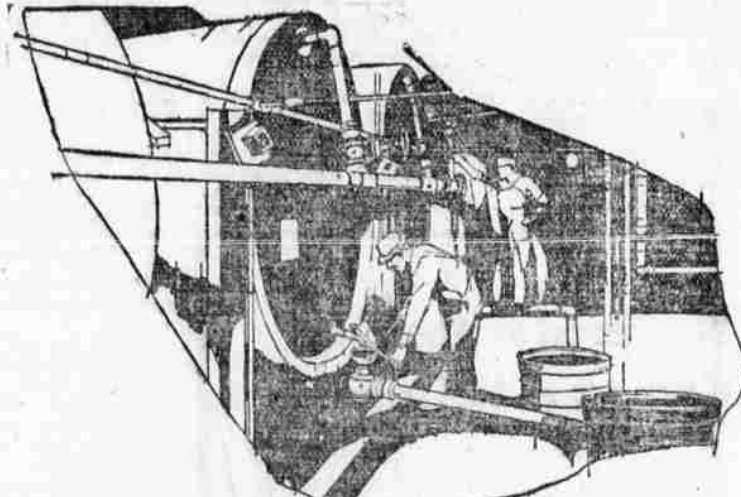
