County Wants a Gift and Asks Railroad to Be a Generous Giver

In a letter prepared by District Attorney Evans, says the Portland Oregonian, and signed by the county commissioner, the Oregon-Washington Railroad & Navigation company is requested to cede the 20 acres of property it owns at Multnomah Falls to the county for use as a public park, so the county can spend money there for needed improvements. The comfort station at this pleasure spot is entirely inadequate, but the railroad company does not feel justified in improvements on land to which the vast majority of tourists go by automobile instead of train, and the county cannot spend any of its funds in improving privately owned property, explained Mr. Evans.

If there are government restrictions on the grant of land which forbids the railroad from disposing of it to the county by gift, the O-W. R. & N. is asked to relinquish the title to the government, which could then turn it over to the county.

By act of congress of March 3, 1875 the railroad company received a 100 foot-wide right of way along the bank of the Columbia river, and at certain distances was allowed 20 acres for depot grounds. The railroad selected one of these depot sites at Multnomah Falls. Directly to the rear of the 20 acres, south of the falls, which in the railroad land, the property was purchased by S. Benson and turned into public park.

Since War Prussia Has More Women Than Men

BERLIN, Oct. 4.—The war has left Prussia with a surplus of women over men, there being now, it is estimated, 1,197 females for every thousand males. This, it would be generally assumed, correspondingly diminishes women's matrimonial prospects in Prussia.

Dr. Robert Bohla, a government expert on vital statistics expects, however, an increase over normal percentages of marriages in Germany, contending that such increase is a natural consequence of all wars. He says that wage earners generally marry more rapidly than do others after war because of the improvement in their economic condition due to the increased wages.

The number of marriages in Prussia last year was about 109,000 less than took place in the last peace year when there was a surplus of only five women to every thousand men.

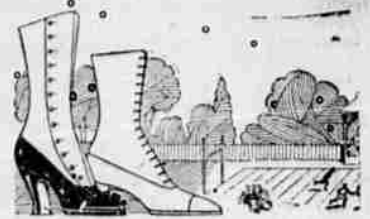
