CELEBRATION NOVEMBER 11

AMERICAN LEGION PLANS BIG
DONGS FOR ARMISTICE DAY

Arthur Van Fleet Heads General
Committee of Five—Ralph Huron
in Charge of Parade.

La Grande is to be the scene of a big celebration on November 11, or Armistice Day, when all the ex-service men and women of La Grande and vicinity, gather for a day full of good times and fun. This announcement has been made by the American Legion who have their committees appointed. These committees have been working hard, and although their plans are not complete, yet they have worked along far enough to know what they are going to do.

According to the committee, the Ad Club will tender a big feed to all of the members of the American Legion at noon. This will be followed in the afternoon by a parade, consisting of all of war time organizations and their members. It is possible, it is hoped to have all of the American Legion members and all of the ex-service men who are not members, the canteen ladies, the Red Cross, and the Home Guard members in the parade.

Immediately after the parade, the athletic or sport program will begin. This will be held on the streets and will be of a military nature to some extent, for there will be dispatch riding, and many other things for which the boys were trained while in the service. Prizes will be given and there promises to be much competition in a relay race around one of the city blocks by men of different squads.

In the evening there will be a big dance at Rex hall, Dick Lindsay's orchestra, which is composed mostly of ex-service men, will furnish music for the evening. The committee have something up their sleeve and aside from the fact that it is going to happen at 11 o'clock, the official hour for the closing of the big gun, little is known except that everyone who wants to be in on it, is advised to bring along a horn or some other noise producing instrument.

On the general committee which was appointed by American Legion to take charge of the general plans for the day are Arthur Van Fleet, chairman; Everett May, Dick Lindsay, Fritz Lottens, and Miss Ida Rettig. Ralph Huron has been appointed in charge of the parade committee, and no doubt will lead the parade that day. Lot Snodgrass and David Stoddard are also assisting Mr. Huron on this committee.

MANY KINDS OF MONEY USED

BUDAPEST, Oct. 4.—Many kinds of money are in circulation in this city. Blue money, that is, the money of the Austro-Hungarian Bank, is or hand in very limited quantities. Then there is good white money with a ten per cent. discount, and bad white money that is worth only one-fifth of its face value. Finally, there is green money, the five crown note of the state savings bank, with a thirty per cent. discount. Curb exchanges have been formed where these money change hands in great quantities.

Budapest, where earlier a newspaper appeared every hour is living almost without newspapers of its own. The people satisfy their curiosity from the Vienna papers which are sold on the streets by thousands. They were forbidden for a time but now have been released, and the news vendors make tremendous profits and get four and five crowns for a single copy. The theatres that have reopened are crammed full.

Budapest is slowly beginning to recover and come back to life, under the protection of the Rumanian bayonet.

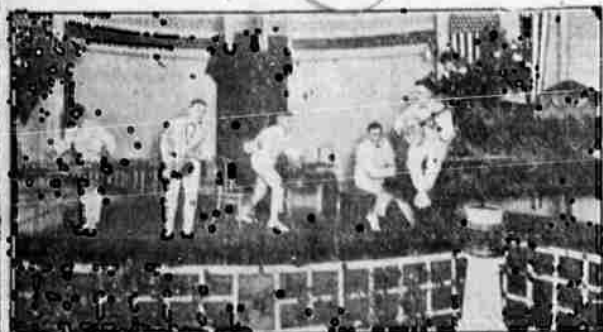
