EMMA GOLDMAN TO BE DEPORTED

BASE FOUNDER CONSIDERATION BY AUTHORITIES.

Alexander Berkman Will Also Be Deported Says Attorney General Palmer.

WASHINGTON, Nov. 17.—Replying to a senate inquiry as to what had been done toward deporting Emma Goldman and Alexander Berkman, attorney general Palmer declared today night that the woman's claim to American citizenship was "fallacious," and that Berkman, by his own admission, was an anarchist.

The Goldman case is under consideration by immigration authorities at New York and the attorney general's statement was taken to mean that the government would soon attempt to send her back to Russia, where she was born.

Dismissing Emma Goldman's claim to citizenship, Mr. Palmer said she was 24 years old when her father was naturalized and that her age barred her from inheriting naturalization rights from him. The fact that her husband obtained his citizenship through fraud, Mr. Palmer said, cancelled any claim she might have established through that score.

The ramifications to which the plot and plans of the group of anarchists headed by Emma Goldman have extended were reviewed by the attorney general. Declaring that both Matthew Schmidt and David Kaplan, who are serving prison sentences for complicity in the destruction of the Los Angeles Times building, were members of the Goldman clan, he showed also that she advocated violence and had incited riots as early as 1893 when she was sentenced to serve one year on Blackwell's island after indictment on these charges.

Mr. Palmer included in the statement in a transcript of the confession of Conzelmann (who shot President McKinley, in which he told of the influence Emma Goldman's teachings had exercised on his life. Further investigating by government agents proved that he had not only heard her speak but frequently had consulted with her as to methods to be employed in effecting the destruction of the government.

The connection of both Berkman and Emma Goldman with the Hobbes movement also was emphasized by Mr. Palmer. The activities of the Union of Russian Workers, said to be one of the most dangerous organizations in America and against which the government has directed a vigorous campaign, has been traced directly to the Goldman-Berkman propaganda headquarters, he said.

OREGON QUAKES SLIGHT ACCORDING TO RECORDS KEPT

EUGENE, Nov. 18.—Many people believe that no earthquakes occur in Oregon. This is contrary to fact, according to Dr. W. G. Smith, professor of geology at the University of Oregon, who claims that the best secured records have been kept.

The shocks are so slight it was explained that people are not aware that an earthquake is taking place. This state is not as liable to have as many earthquakes as Washington and California, as much of Oregon is older and more stable terrain.

When an earthquake occurs, Dr. Smith explains, cracks are made in the affected rocks. If these are large and oil is present, a large amount is liable to seep away. The same is true for the water supply. Some districts being well supplied while others are left without water.

MOB LYNCHES NEGRO ROBBER

ONE HUNDRED MASKED MEN HANG PRISONER.

Victim Was Said to Have Beaten and Robbed Missouri Farmer at Moberly.

MOBERLY, Mo., Nov. 17.—A negro, one of four said to have beaten and robbed Edward Thomson, a farmer here, Thursday night, was lynched here Sunday by a mob of 100 masked men. The negro's three companions, who had been taken from the jail at Macon early Sunday and spirited here, escaped but later it was reported two had been captured and incarcerated at a point unknown to the mob.

Feeling against the negroes is running high and it is reported farmers have gone to adjacent counties in search of the recaptured blacks. Local authorities said the negroes admitted they were I. W. W.

Fearing mob violence, Sheriff Owens Saturday night took the quartet to Macon county. Hearing of this a mob motored there and demanded that Sheriff Jesse Stamper turn over the negroes to them. The sheriff pleaded with the men, but the jail keys were taken forcibly from him, and the blacks were returned here just before daybreak, clad only in their night clothes.

A large fire had been built in a public park, and on seeing this the negroes set up howls.

A rope was placed over the head of one and swung over a limb of a tree. The mob pulled and the limb broke. The negro started running as he fell. Four guns flashed and he was killed instantly.

At the sound of the shots, the other three ran.

The negroes are alleged to have beaten Thomson into unconsciousness and robbed him of \$12 on the outskirts of Moberly.
