GERMANY DAZED OVER DEMANDS

ENTENTE WILL SEND CHIEF COMMISSION TO BERLIN.

Housing Requirements Made By Naval and Military Commissions Startle Germans.

BERLIN, Nov. 22.—Germany is fairly dazed by the demands and requirements, to the Entente military and naval commissions for the housing of their supervisory forces, which according to the peace treaty, may have their headquarters at the seat of the German government, and place sub-commissions at any desired point in Germany.

The Entente has given notice that it will send a chief commission to Berlin, and ten sub-commissions to other points. It demands, from Berlin, hotel accommodations comprising over 500 rooms, housing for 300 non-commissioned officers and men, garage facilities for 60 automobiles also being required. These are the demands for the army and naval forces.

For the air forces the Entente wants 200 rooms in a hotel, 100 office rooms, housing for 450 persons, and garage space for 60 automobiles. The figures look large to Germans for guests at all the big hotels even now are happy to be able to creep into a bathroom and snatch some sleep.

The council of states has decided that the money agreed upon to furnish quarters for the Entente missions, 5,000,000 marks, was not enough. It is, however, rooms, hotels, dwellings,

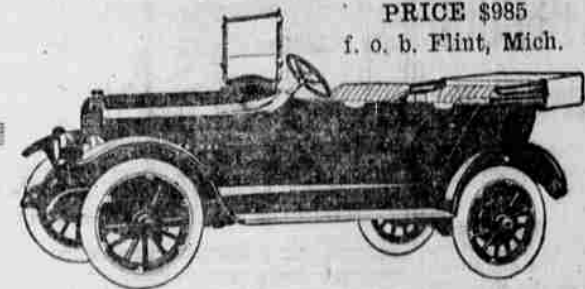
