SUFFRAGISTS WILL MEET

SON FRANCISCO, Nov. 23.—Leading suffragists from all parts of the United States are expected here tomorrow for a conference of the Women Voters of America.

Prior to this all women for better citizenship and consideration of Americanization, child labor and legislation for women will be taken up.

Carrie Chapman Catt, president of the National American Woman Suffrage Association; Mrs. C. W. McCulloch of Chicago, chairman of the department of the unification of laws; Lenore of Women Voters; Dr. Valera Parker, chairman of the department of social hygiene; Miss Julia Lathrop and Mrs. E. P. Costigan of Washington, D. C., have been asked to speak.

The high cost of living and the proposed organization of a league of women voters in California will be discussed.

Mrs. Roberts J. Burdette and Mrs. Robert Armstrong Dean, chairman of the California suffrage ratification committee of the American Women Suffrage Association are assisting in arranging for the conference.

SNAKE RIVER STOCK MEN HAVE TURKEYS

In addition to their extensive operations in cattle and sheep, Dobbin & Huffman will cut some figure in the poultry market this season. On their Jim creek ranch on the Snake river they have raised 300 turkeys which are now in fine condition and ready for the Thanksgiving market.

Notice is by this given that the county court of Union county, Oregon, will receive sealed bids in writing until 3 o'clock in the afternoon of the 22nd day of December, 1919, at the County Court room in La Grande, Union county, Oregon, for the purchase of Serial Bonds of said county for the construction of permanent roads therein, amounting to the sum of \$100,000.00, in denominations of \$1,000.00 each, and immediately thereafter said bids will be publicly opened; said bonds are dated December 15th, 1919, and mature and are redeemable numerically in the following order and at the following dates:

Series No. 1 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1925; Series No. 2 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1926; Series No. 3 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1927; Series No. 4 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1928; Series No. 5 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1929; Series No. 6 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1930; Series No. 7 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1931; Series No. 8 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1932; Series No. 9 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1933; Series No. 10 for \$20,000 on January 15, 1934; each of said bonds to bear interest at the rate of five per cent per annum, payable semi-annually on January 15 and July 15 of each year, principal and interest payable in gold coin at the fiscal agency of the state of Oregon in New York City, N. Y.

All bids for said bonds must be accompanied by a certified check of a banking institution for two per centum of the face value of the bonds bid for, and the successful bidder must be prepared to pay for and receive said bonds within ten days of sale; checks of unsuccessful bidders will be returned.

The court reserves the right to reject any or all bids.

The approving legal opinion of the District Attorney J. S. Rodgin, and of Teal, Minor & Winfree of Portland, Oregon, will be furnished to the successful bidder.

The assessed valuation of the taxable property of said county at last assessment is \$24,972,695.00; and the indebtedness of said county exclusive of that incurred for these bonds is nothing.
