BRITISH GOVERNMENT

LONDON, Nov. 28.—The government won a sweeping victory in the House of Commons today when a motion calling for the appointment of a committee to inquire into the cost of production and the price of coal was rejected.

ENTENTE DEMANDS ARE REFUSED

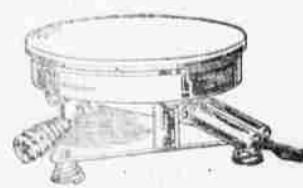
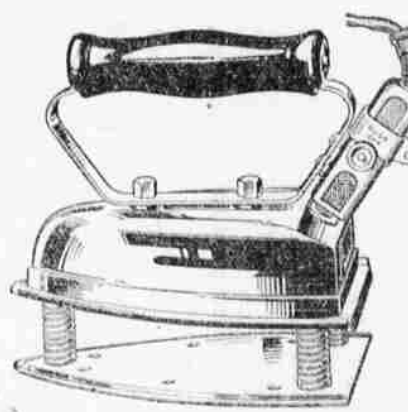
