TWO GAMES GO BY DEFAULT

EXHIBITION GAMES IN THE CITY LEAGUE ARE EXCELLENT

Purity Squad Defeats Lumberjacks by Score of 22 to 18 in Game in Which Every Play Counted.

Because the railroad shops basketball team in the city league defaulted to the Purity Squad and the Retailers defaulted to the Lumberjacks, the regular games in the league were not played last night. However, the Lumberjacks and Retailers played an exhibition game which proved to be one of the fastest games of basketball ever played here. The result was in doubt until the final plays had been executed by both sides. The teams were exceptionally evenly matched.

The final result was 22 for the Purity Squad and 18 for the Lumberjacks. At the end of the first half, the score stood 9 to 8 in favor of the Lumberjacks, but during the second half the Lumberjacks couldn't make more than an additional 9 points, while the Purity Squad collected up 14 more, giving them the lead by four points.

Bud Theison, for the purity squad, made four baskets in the second half. P. E. Taylor played a first class game at forward with Theison for the Purities and made two field baskets and two foul goals. E. Lyman, center, played a sensational game, racking two goals from center, three field goals being his total during the game. Ash and Wright played a good defensive game.

Robertson, for the Lumberjacks, made three field goals, while Ballantyne made three and one foul goal. Carr substituted for a short time for Ballantyne at forward, the latter having been slightly injured during the course of the game. Larson at center made two field and one foul goals. Murray and Smith played the defensive end of the game for the lumberjacks.

PROFITS FROM CAPITAL ASSETS IS TAXABLE INCOME, SAY OFFICIALS

PORTLAND, Feb. 24.—Numerous companies have reached the Bureau of Internal Revenue relative to the decision of United States District Court in Connecticut in the Brewster case, in which it was held that gains and profits realized from the sale of capital assets is not taxable income. The United States Attorney for Connecticut has been authorized to perfect an appeal to the Supreme Court of the United States for a review of the decision. Since Congress, under the provisions of the income tax Acts of 1913, 1916 and 1918, has directed the taxation as income of such gains and profits, the Bureau will continue to collect the tax thereon, unless and until the Supreme Court shall hold that provision of law to be unconstitutional.

The same question is involved in the Eldorado and Ryerson cases which were argued in the Supreme Court some weeks ago. A decision in these cases undoubtedly will settle the general question. In view of the severe penalties provided by law for false and fraudulent income tax returns, taxpayers are warned not to omit from their returns for the year 1920 such gains and profits.
