BAKER, Mar. 3.—A new company was formed here this week which takes over the wholesale printing and stamp business of Wesley Andrews, and also absorbing the post card factory and business of Pacific Photo company in which Wesley Andrews was formerly interested with A. G. Gaumeister, the plant of which was moved from Salem to Baker over a year ago. The name of the new company is Wesley Andrews, Inc.
The capital stock, issued and subscribed was \$50,000, divided into 500 shares of \$100 each par value. The officers elected are Wesley Andrews, president; O. B. Mount, vice-president; Thelma Andrews, secretary-treasurer.
