PEDAGOGUES TO CONVE

EASTERN OREGON EDUCATORS PLAN SESSION HERE.

Program Includes Eminent State and Local Men—Two Local School Men on Program.

The spring meeting of the Superintendents and Principals' Club of Eastern Oregon will be held in La Grande on March 26, according to announcements received here this week by local teachers. Sessions will be held in the La Grande high school both morning and afternoon, the sessions beginning at 9 and at 1.

The program includes speakers who have made a study of the special educational problems on which they will talk. The morning session will be devoted to two formal addresses and two discussions of special subjects of interest to teachers, the discussions to be led by men of eminence in Eastern Oregon educational circles.

Prentiss Brown, superintendent of school at Baker, will address the teachers on "Mental Tests," and H. R. Benjamin, superintendent of schools of Umatilla, will talk on "Measurements of Teachings," during the morning.

Following the formal addresses, discussions of "Teachers' Agencies" and "Uniform High School Records" will complete the morning's program. The former will be led by Superintendent M. H. Sines, of Boardman, while Superintendent H. M. James, of Hupner, will lead the latter discussion.

The afternoon session will be opened by Superintendent A. C. Hampton, of La Grande, with an address on "Making the Course of Study Function." Following his address State Superintendent of Schools J. A. Churchill will speak on "Preparation for Citizenship Through the Schools."

The afternoon's discussions will be made under the leadership of Superintendent D. R. White, of Wallawa, and H. M. Duflois, principal of the La Grande high school. Professor White will lead a discussion on "Teacher Training," while Professor Duflois will have the leadership of a round table discussion on general educational problems.

The Eastern Oregon meeting has come to be one of the most important educational gatherings of the school year. School administrators are given a chance to get into direct touch with each other and the state superintendent. D. W. Baitnott is president and R. W. Travenner is secretary of the Eastern Oregon Club.
