THE STORAGE BATTERY

THE CHARGING CIRCUIT.

The charging circuit consists of the generator, cut-out, ammeter, storage battery and wires necessary. The Delco circuit has no cut-out and uses the switch as a medium to connect or open circuit between battery and generator.

The charging generator is of the shunt wound type and usually has 3rd brush voltage regulation.

Generator outputs vary according to make and type and also are built to accommodate the storage battery, for which it is used.

Troubles in the charging circuit are as follows: open or loose connections; loose ground wire on battery or connects the lights will burn very brightly when engine is running, and in some cases burn up the globes.

Burnt cut-out points show a heavy discharge on ammeter and when this happens disconnect the wires on the battery and see a repair man. High mica on the commutator keeps the generator from charging and causes heavy sparking at the brushes. A piece of sand paper applied to the commutator will remedy this condition. Worn brushes should be replaced, and fitted to commutator before being used.

Too much oil on commutator keeps the generator from charging. Also, dirt from brushes, loose, armature wires, brushes do not fit, or brush springs are weak.

Third brush may be out of adjustment; field coils may be open or shorted or insulation broken through.

All these ills and many more happen in the charging circuit and most of these ills the average man can repair if common sense is used. Most things like these require good horse sense.

UP-TO-MINUTE AUTOMOTIVE NOTES.

Extension Arm for Spotlight.

The awkwardness, and sometimes danger, of having to lean over the steering wheel to adjust the windshield spotlight, is responsible for the production of a new automobile accessory. It consists of a small telescoping arm, with clamp and universal joint at one end, and a ball-shaped handle at the other. Clamped to the spotlight shank, the joint and telescoping arm are adjusted so that the ball handle is always within a few inches of the steering wheel.

Snow Plow for Automobile.

A New York man is the inventor of a three-bladed snow plow to be mounted in front of an automobile, the center blade breaking the way for the side ones, which open tracks for a car's wheels.

Converts Tractor into Wagon.

A Missourian has designed a farm tractor that can be converted into a road wagon, the drive being through the front wheels, while two wheels replace a single rear wheel when it becomes a truck.

Tractor Pushes Lawn Mowers.

A garden tractor has been designed that pushes three lawn mowers in front of it so that the grass is not flattened before being reached by the knives.

Alarm Sounds if Auto Moves.

An automobile-theft alarm devised by a Nebraska inventor utilizes the drive shaft to operate its own bell or horn signal when the car is moved improperly. A friction gear, thrown

into or out of engagement with the shaft by a cam, is enclosed with the alarm in a riveted steel case, fixed to the shaft housing and radius magnet, so that turning the key in the lock stops the engine and sets the alarm. The lock is located in the floor of the driving compartment.
