ALL BOYS TO BE TAUGHT TO SWIM HERE IN SPRING

Preparations are being made by A. Edwin Pryke, physical director of the Y. M. C. A., for teaching swimming to every boy in the La Grande schools over 10 years of age. The plan is being worked out with the co-operation of the school authorities and the principals of the various schools, as well as superintendent Hampton Lave expressed their approval of the movement.

As one of the preliminary steps, every boy over 10 years of age is being indexed according to his swimming ability. A number of boys who already can swim have expressed the desire to help Mr. Pryke in the work and these will be given the opportunity of earning the Y. M. C. A. swimming teacher certificate in this manner. These older boys will have to teach 10 non-swimmers to swim a minimum of 50 feet in order to secure the rating of teacher.

In making the plans for giving this instruction the work will be extended over such a period as to assure that all will learn swimming thoroughly. Classes will begin shortly and, by the time school is out, every boy will be able to swim if the plans of Mr. Pryke do not miscarry.
