### HORSES SOLD AT PRICE CONSIDERED BELOW FEED COST

The stock raiser is not desiring a price commensurate with the cost of raising stock, according to H. N. Pratt, a Shorthorn breeder of Union, Pa. In discussing the present situation as it affects stockmen, called attention to the high cost of feed and the high retail cost of meat while the producer gets much less than is the cost of raising stock in many cases.

He told of one farmer selling a cow recently for \$11 that would have been considered cheap at \$25 a year ago. In another instance, he stated, a number of halter-broke fillies were sold for prices ranging from \$16 to \$28. The hay these young horses had eaten alone cost more than some of their brought. There is hope for the man who can afford to hold his stock, but the farmer who is forced to sell now is being squeezed hard at such prices.

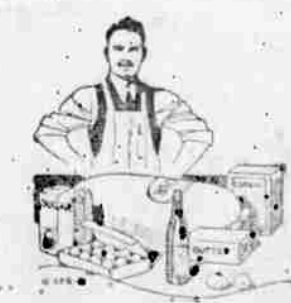
