#### STANFIELD ON WAY TO EAST

United States Senator Robert N. Stanfield, passed through La Grande Monday morning on his way to Washington, D. C., to resume his work in the national congress.

To a representative of the Observer, Senator Stanfield stated that the brief time he had been on duty forced him to the belief that President Harding had selected most wisely the men for his cabinet and that the national congress feels deeply the conditions now spreading over the country.

"We will enact tariff legislation at the special session," said Senator Stanfield, "I feel sure. It will not be a finished tariff bill for that requires long deliberation, but knowing the sentiment in the senate to protect the farming industry, which is shared also by the President, I know we will have a tariff law working before very long."

Senator Stanfield was on his way back to the capitol after having spent several days in Portland organizing his interests into one large corporation. Hereafter, his time will be devoted to national matters and the sheep, wool, cattle and farming industries in which he is interested will be under his direct supervision for that purpose.

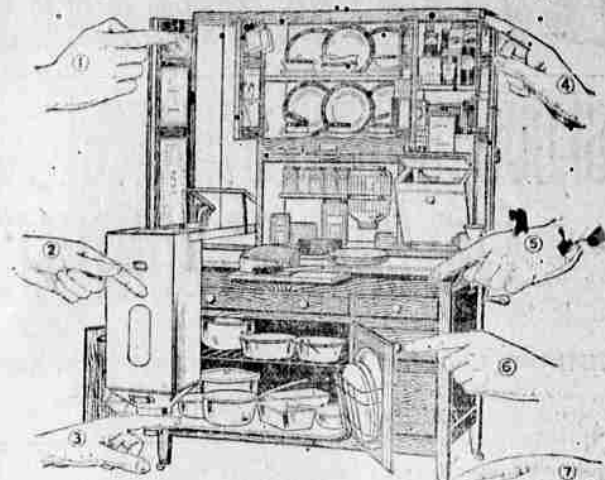
