LOCAL EGG IS STILL IN LEAD

JOHN WILSON'S HEN BEATS HOOD RIVER RECORD.

Egg Produced Here Quarter of An Inch Larger than Claimant Of Championship.

A Hood River farmer, Hans Lage, claims to have a hen that has smashed all previous egg-laying records by laying an egg measuring seven and one-quarter inches the small way and eight and one-half inches the long way. He has challenged his fellow poultrymen in the state to show an egg larger than that.

John Wilson of La Grande, exhibited an egg here several days ago that beats the Hood River product. A Rhode Island red, owned by Mr.

Wilson, produced an egg seven and one-quarter inches one way and eight and three-quarter inches the other way. This egg is somewhat larger than the usual size laid by Mr. Wilson's hen, but she lays one nearly every day in the year.
