## FOREST RANGERS RESPONSIBLE

HAVE MANAGEMENT OF 4,360,000 ACRES OF LAND.

Meeting This Past Week in Baker of Rangers and Supervisors Was Well Attended.

BAKER, Apr. 18.—The meeting this past week-end in Baker of Forest Rangers and Supervisors of the Whitman, Malheur, Umatilla and Wallowa National Forests was attended by practically all the field men from these organizations, as well as by seven officials from the District Office in Portland, closed yesterday. These rangers and supervisors are charged with the business management of approximately 4,360,000 acres of government land. Last year this management resulted in the sale of about 60,000,000 board feet of timber and brought about \$165,500 into the federal treasury. Thirty-five per cent of this amount is paid back to the counties from which the timber was cut, to be used on roads and schools. This revenue was derived from about 138 commercial sales, each of which requires considerable field supervision and office work. Not included in the above amount of timber there was about 6,175,000 feet granted free of charge to homesteaders and settlers, while 1,991,000 feet was sold at the approximate cost of administering each sale.

These same men are also charged with the administration of grazing lands which carry 450,500 sheep and 107,500 cattle and horses. The cattle and horses represent 60 separate co-operative associations which are working with the forest service for better range methods, and for the control and suppression of forest fires.

## BROTHER IS DROWNED

RIDDLE, Ore., Apr. 18.—The bodies of E. J. Farris and Peter Kuffner Jr., drowned in the south Umpqua river, near Riddle, on March 26, have not been recovered. Patrol men have been watching the river, but have been reduced by the coroner to two men. The river was dragged and dynamited for a week.

Kuffner, president, and Joe Crahan, manager of the Crahan-Kuffner sawmill, and E. J. Farris, an employe, went down the river to pick up a lost cable, and look up two boats that had been lost some time before. Their boat capsized in mid-stream. Farris could not swim, but the others were expert swimmers. Crahan swam to shore. Kuffner evidently lost his life in an endeavor to save Farris.

E. J. Farris is a son of Mrs. R. E. Woods, agent at Duncan, and a brother of Mrs. Maude F. Cooper, of Hilliard, Ore. He leaves a wife and two little boys.
