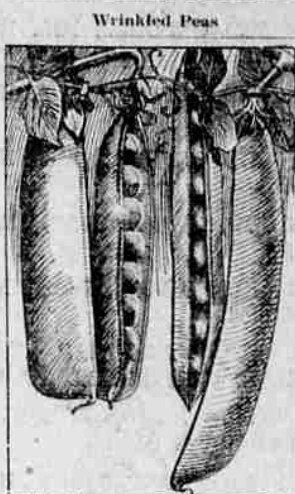

same pod. Peas have become very different since the succulent tribe became thoroughly developed under selection and hybridization.

If you had to select the best quality pea merely by looking at the seed, a few years back it would have been Holston's choice. Now it is another matter. Suppose you had twenty different samples of seed peas to select from and you wished to select the best variety for your garden as a matter of quality. If you picked the one with the most wrinkles in you wouldn't be far wrong, so far as quality of sweetness is concerned. Of course you couldn't tell about the height of the plant nor its productiveness, but you would have solved the sweetness problem.

Sweetness and wrinkles are the two combination that counts. Another factor in favor of the wrinkled pea is that it is sweet and tender over a longer period, and can be cooked nearer maturity than the round seeded sorts.

So much for the wrinkles, but the smooth seeded sorts should not be discarded by any manner of means, because they have one quality that makes them as valuable for their purpose as the wrinkled varieties. They are the earliest of all garden crops because they will stand cold and wet that will, in many cases, cause the wrinkled varieties to rot in the ground.

There is one factor about these round-seeded varieties that must be

remembered. They must be picked while the pods are young. At this stage they are of fine enough quality and sweet enough for anybody. But let them get a little over the line towards maturity and they lose their flavor.

If you have never "doped" your peas before planting time, try it this year. It will pay in growth, yield and quality.

The proper "dope" is a nitrogen

culture known under various trade names and kept in stock at a moderate price by seed men. Merely make the solution according to directions that come with this nitrogen culture and soak the peas in it before planting. Peas, beans, and their relatives all attract to their roots bacteria, which take nitrogen direct from the air. This culture sets the bacteria to work more quickly than if the plant were left to it.
