## PURGATORY DISCUSSED

Despite the inclemency of the weather, an excellent crowd was present at the Catholic church last night and listened to a very clear explanation of the Catholic doctrine of Purgatory and a wonderful sermon on the Last Judgment. In his instruction on Purgatory, Father Donegan said in part: "The Catholic church teaches that while there is heaven for those who die free from the guilt of mortal sin and a place of eternal judgment for those who live at enmity with God, there is also a third place after death called Purgatory, where souls are detained in further satisfaction for mortal sins committed and forgiven in this life or atone for venial sin which has not been pardoned. This teaching concerning a purgatorial state has a scriptural basis, not only in the old testament but in the new testament as well. In II Machabees chapter 12, we find the statement, 'It is, therefore, a holy and wholesome thought to pray for the dead, that they may be loosed from their sins.' Besides being scriptural, the doctrine of purgatory is founded upon the history and traditions of the Catholic church, running back to its earliest ages; it is a belief held by the Jews of pre-Christian times and as well by the Catholics of the Greek Schism who departed from unity with the Church of Rome during the ninth century."

### Appeals to Human Heart

"Finally, it is a doctrine which appeals to the human heart because it furnishes a reasonable and legitimate means by which we may keep ourselves in communion through prayer with those who have departed. The poet Tennyson expresses this Catholic belief most beautifully when he puts into the lips of the dying king, in closing stanzas of 'Morte d'Arthur' (the death of Arthur), these touching words of farewell: 'If thou shouldst never see my face again, pray for my soul; more things are wrought by prayer than this world dreams of.'"

"A belief in purgatory or a middle state for the souls of those who have departed, is held by many members of the Episcopal Church, and only recently a prominent minister expressed regret that this beautiful teaching had been abandoned by so many Christians separated from the communion of the Catholic Church."

### Father Quinn's Lecture

The sermon delivered by Father Quinn showed in a logical way convincing reasons for the necessity of a general judgment on the last day. "Man has sinned against the members of society as well as against God and it is but just that all should be at the bar of justice to receive our reparation. As members of society we have a great responsibility toward our fellow creature. It logically follows therefore, that we must have a judgment of our public life, our crimes against society, and had example. A general judgment is also necessary to manifest the malice of sin, and the virtue might be publicly rewarded and vice publicly condemned and eternally punished."
