Make sure that wind-shield, top and side-curtains are so adjusted as to afford your guests the maximum of comfort.

Provide linen dusters for the summer guests and heavy cloaks, coats and gloves for those who brave the winter winds in your care. Have goggles at hand for those who care to protect their eyes with them.

TUBERCULAR FUND FOR COWS EXHAUSTED WITHIN THREE MONTHS

PORTLAND, May 3.—The \$3,000 the county appropriated to pay for tubercular cows killed by order of the state veterinarian during the current 12 months has been exhausted during the first three months of the year, the county commissioners reported this week when a farmer brought in a bill for a cow.

The commissioners can exceed their budget by 10 per cent, the state law provides. The state law also provides, however, that the county must pay half the price of all infected cows killed.
