The preliminary surveys for the proposed Lower Beaver Creek pipe line were completed last week and maps, profiles, estimates, etc., are now being made up in the office of the consulting engineer in Portland, according to the weekly report of City Manager George Barrett.

The receipts of the treasurer's office, according to the report, were \$2250.78 for the week. The weekly water rents contributed the largest amount of \$1494.77. Subscriptions of the treasurer's office were \$420.21. The records of the office reported receipt of \$107.50 from the police department as fines and penalties and forty-nine warrants are issued totalling \$675.22.
