EUGENE IS HOST TO STATE GRANGE

ATTENDANCE FIRST DAY SETS
NEW RECORD.

Delegates and Visitors Are Entertained At a Banquet By Chamber of Commerce.

EUGENE, June 3.—The 48th annual convention of the Oregon State Grange opened in Eugene Tuesday with the largest attendance in the history of Oregon, according to members who have attended every one for many years.

The street parade and the banquet given the delegates and other visitors by the Eugene Chamber of Commerce at the Methodist and Christian churches were big features of the session.

The parade, made up for the most part of automobiles and trucks from the different Lane county granges, was staged for the entertainment of the visitors.

Practically every grange in Lane county had a float, besides numerous cars. There were in line about 35 truck loads of pure bred cattle, swine, sheep and goats.

After a banquet Tuesday the auditorium of the First Christian church was crowded with grangers who were formally welcomed by C. D. Rorer, in behalf of the chamber of commerce, Dean Walker for the city, J. L. Campbell, president of the University of Oregon.

C. E. Spence, state master and W. R. Wing, Lane county Pomona Grange master, responded. Mr. Spence did not deliver his opening address, owing to the fact that so much of his time was taken up with the business of opening, until Wednesday.

The principal points dwelt upon were the condition of agriculture, transportation, marketing and taxation, being an endeavor to show that those engaged in agriculture have suffered more financial loss during the recent period of "deflation" than

all other interests combined and that the financial losses of the farmer in the last year have been from five billion to ten billion dollars.
