## "Jack Hit Me Harder Than Georges," Says Battling Levinsky

Editor's Note—Battling Levinsky, the Philadelphia light-heavyweight, is one of two American boxers who has met both Jack Dempsey and Georges Carpentier, the other being Gunboat Smith. Levinsky, therefore, is well qualified to write an opinion of the comparative fighting ability of the American titleholder and his French challenger.

*Battling Levinsky*

Let it be understood in the beginning that I am not going to pick the winner of the Carpentier-Dempsey fight at Jersey City on July 2.

It will merely be my endeavor to size up the two as I have found by actual ring combat, first with Dempsey, who disposed of me in three rounds, and then with Carpentier, who disposed of me in four rounds.

On the basis of what I found them to be in their battles with me I will give it as my opinion that Dempsey is the better man. Therefore he ought to win.

#### Demp Stronger

Dempsey is a bigger, stronger and harder hitter, and in addition is very fast. He must not, however, hold the Frenchman too cheaply.

The challenger is a fast and hard two-handed hitter and a much better man than he is generally credited with being.

He is always trying to do the unexpected, and takes advantage of every opening. He is cool, heady, always dangerous, and what also is a good asset, always supremely confident. Carpentier, furthermore, is the better boxer, has a habit of feinting an opponent into an opening and when he does he swings in with everything, putting his entire body into the punch and wasting nothing.

#### Carp Has Punch

In my fight with Carpentier he hit me a punch on the chin in the first round, the effects of which never left me until the finish. It convinced me that he could hit hard and until the

end all that I could do was to fight on the defensive, but his craft and coolness and constant waiting for the right opening finally prevailed.

With all of Carpentier's qualifications that I have set forth, I do not believe, however, that he will be able to overcome the superior natural fighting might of the champion.

I make no stock in the story that an attempt will be made to build Carpentier up to somewhere near Dempsey's weight. It would do him no good.

#### Carp Is Wise

The fact that Carpentier is going to work three days a week and rest the remaining four should arouse no suspicions.

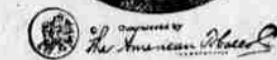
I think it is the best campaign he could adopt, until about two weeks from the end, when, if I were he, I would get down to the real intensive stuff every day, hardening up and getting the wind into the best possible shape.

The Frenchman is always in shape and near his best fighting weight and therefore does not need to work hard.

Let me repeat in concluding, that I am not picking a winner, but from what I know of the two men, knowledge gained by actual experience with them in the ring, I believe Dempsey is the better man.

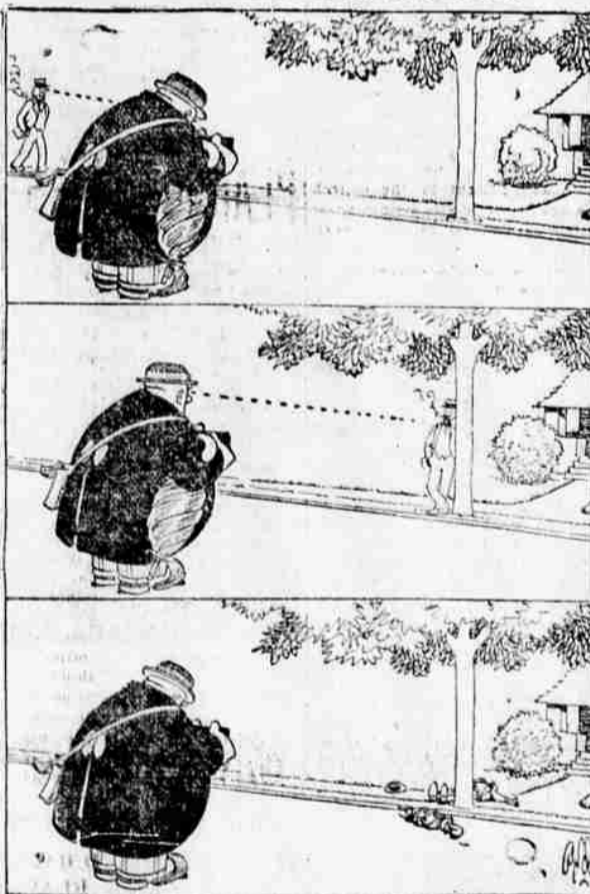
