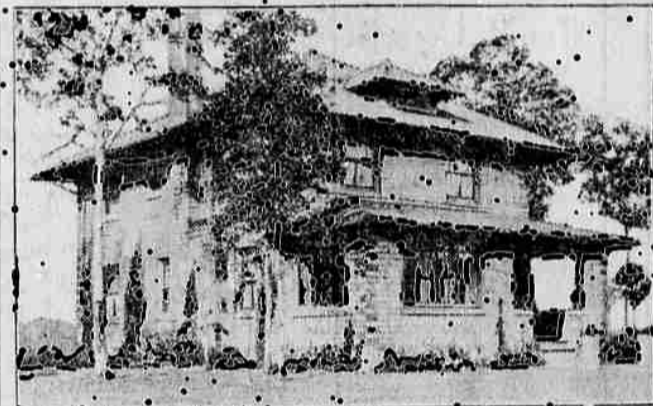

First Floor Plan.

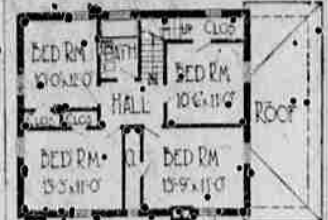
