Mr. MacLean who demonstrated his popularity with picture fans in "Twenty-three and Half Hours' Leave" in which he co-starred with Doris May, delighted anew with his role in this capital Paramount photoplay, which was produced by Thomas H. Ince.

Mr. MacLean is seen as a rogue in "The Jailbird," but a lovable chap for all that.
