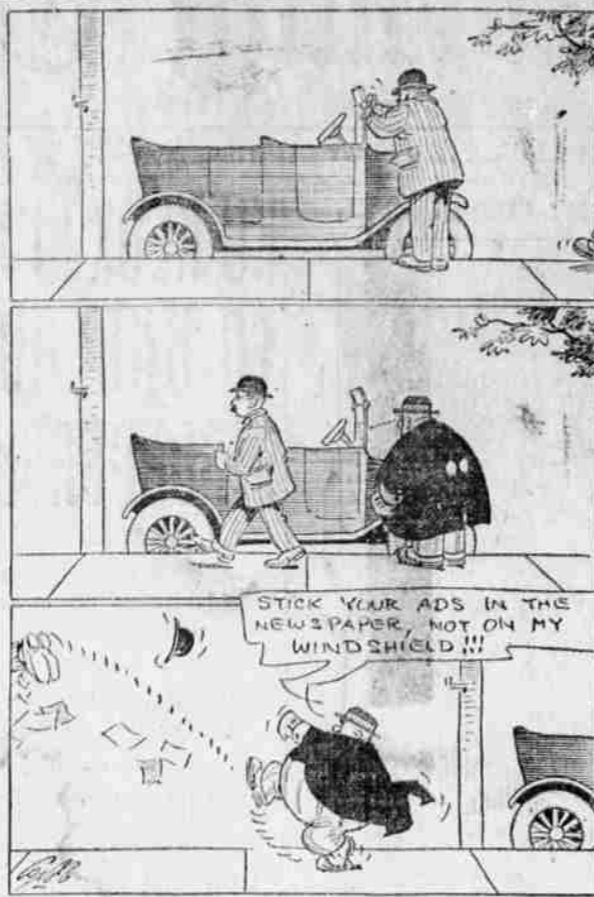

PINCHOT AND FORD DISAGREE

Former Issues Statement Alleging Ford Goes Counter to Roosevelt Policies

Gifford Pinchot, friend of Theodore Roosevelt and still a firm supporter of the conservation policies Roosevelt stood for, has issued an analysis of the offer of Henry Ford to take over the government property at Muscle Shoals on the Tennessee river from the point of view of a Roosevelt conservationist. He does not believe in turning down the offer of Mr. Ford summarily but he does believe that the offer should be modified and clarified in such a manner as to conform to the Roosevelt policies more than it does now.

"The first part of the Ford offer is to ease the Wilson Dam and dam No. 2 for 100 years, with indefinite renewals, provided the government will complete them and install machinery to produce \$50,000 horsepower. Mr. Ford offers to pay 6 per cent on the 25 million dollars which he estimates will be necessary to complete this work, or three and four-tenths per cent on 48 million dollars. Mr. Ford's own estimate of the whole government investment in dams, locks, and power houses. Even if we add all other annual payments (the so-called amortization payments and payments for the repair, maintenance, and operating of dams, gates and locks), the total would be equivalent to interests at the rate of only three and six-tenths per cent. Mr. Ford offers also to give the Government 500 horsepower to operate the locks.

"For the waterpower itself Mr. Ford would pay nothing, and that he would be free from all taxes on the property. Other losses of water power rights from the Government not only bear the total cost of building their own addition. The Ford offer is like offering a man three and six-tenths per cent on the cost of his factory as rent, and then asking him

COMPILING FACTS OF GREAT WORTH

People Asking for Information on County Can be Served Quickly

Compilation of the greatest assortment of facts pertaining to this county that has ever been gathered, is now under way in the offices of five different organizations of the state. The Oregon Exhibit Association at Portland, County Agent Avery, County Judge Couch, County Assessor Proctor and the Ad Club are all at work checking up on a list of figures that in a day or two will be ready for distribution. They will go into details never before attempted, and gathered from varied sources and checked and re-checked until they are as near perfect as it is possible to get them. The government census is the primary basis and added to them are figures obtained from the five areas mentioned and then checked against themselves after presentation to the five angles.

The immediate uses of the figures will be to answer a certain type of inquiries coming in to the Ad Club acted into law last year.

The Roosevelt policy provides that all waterpower leases shall be limited to fifty years. The Ford offer asks for 100 years with indefinite renewals.

The Roosevelt policy provides for return of the Government works at the end of fifty years. The Ford offer provides for indefinite private possession of the Government works.

The Roosevelt policy provides for the regulation of the price to the power consumer. The Ford offer, so far as the United States is concerned, provides no check on what the power consumer must pay.

The Roosevelt policy provides that public waterpower taken for profit shall make a return to the public. The Ford offer asks for many hundred thousand horsepower for nothing.

The amount of power Mr. Ford could develop, under his offer, is greater by half than all that is now being developed at Niagara Falls. If Mr. Ford were to pay for it at the rates charged by the Government to other companies that build their own works, as Mr. Ford would not, it would cost him about 150 thousand dollars a year.
