## BAKER'S DAM NEARLY DONE

Materials Nearly All In Mountains for Dam Increasing Water Supply for Mining Center.

BAKER, Aug. 31—Another week it is expected will see all the material for completion of the Goodrich reservoir landed at the site of the dam. All material except one car of cement has arrived in Baker and this is now due. After the material is delivered about three weeks will be required to complete the dam. Water Commissioner George Henry stated today. The work will then be ready for inspection and acceptance by the city. This will be by the first of October if not sooner.

One of the most difficult parts of putting in the dam has been getting the cement, steel and other material to the site. The last four miles of the haul is over new road, a very steep grade, made special to get to the reservoir. Twenty-four four-horse teams have been employed in the work. These teams load from 2000 to 2500 pounds to the trip. The road is badly cut up by the teams

with the dust inches and feet deep. The bulk of the material for the dam is now on the ground and the teaming troubles will soon be over. The elevation of the reservoir is over 7000 feet above sea level, at Baker 2440 feet, making a climb of more than 2500 feet. This gives some idea of the climb in hauling material from here. The greater portion is in the last four miles. Material hauled from Baker is taken in motor trucks to the teamster's camp and there transferred to wagons. Gilmore & Ritchie, the contractors, started pouring cement for the dam last Friday. They are employing 25 men besides the teamsters. Rock for the concrete work is secured about half a mile from the dam. A tunnel 160 feet in length has been completed and is ready for putting in the top pipe, 18 inches in diameter, and a perpendicular shaft 47 feet deep has also been completed ready for the cement work. Control of the outlet to the reservoir is through this shaft. The reservoir complete adds 120,000,000 gallons to the storage capacity of Baker's water system. With this, Commissioner Henry expects that it will be a long time before a water shortage is again felt in Baker. The average present consumption of water through the mains here is approximately 1,750,000 gallons a day. The water system has about 27 miles of pipe lines bringing water to the city reservoirs. These gather water from mountain springs and small streams, that are tormented in the spring, but in the fall the flow of water decreases until by the middle of September it is generally necessary to conserve water. The supply is holding up pretty well this year so far, and it is expected this will be the last year with a water shortage, if it should develop late, as next spring's floods will fill the new reservoir.
