ALL HARMONY AT OPENING OF LEAGUE

No Fixed Slate Seems to Appear to the Popular Branch

UNCLE SAM IS GALLERY GUEST

Dr. Wellington Koo of China Makes the Opening Address to the League Members.

GENEVA, Sept. 6.—The second assembly of the league of nations opened Monday in an atmosphere of optimism and with as much enthusiasm as might reasonably be expected from so sober a body. It was demonstrated that the popular branch of the league was meeting free from a pre-arranged program.

The assembly heard the opening address of Dr. Wellington Koo of China, without having any idea as to who might be selected permanent president.

The only business transacted in the morning was the election of a committee on credentials, and it was not until the luncheon recess that the delegates could exchange notes as to their choice of presiding officer. South America came forward with Dr. Gaston De Cuba of Brazil and Dr. Juan Carlos Blanco, Uruguayan minister at Paris, while there was an important movement in favor of H. A. Van Karnebeck, Dutch minister of foreign affairs, who was eventually elected.

Count Mensdorff of Austria and Professor Panaretov, former Bulgarian minister at Washington, who represented Bulgaria pending the arrival of M. Stambulivsky, the premier, and Bishop Noll of Albania, new members of the league, were the objects of attention when Doctor Koo welcomed them to the assembly. Count Mensdorff was named on the committee on credentials.

Women Represented.
Women were well represented in the delegations. They included Emilie Millard of France, Christine Bonnevi of Norway, Henni Torchammer, Denmark; Mile. Bacarescho, Rumania; Bish Bath Kosha, Siam, and Mme. Wickel, Sweden.
