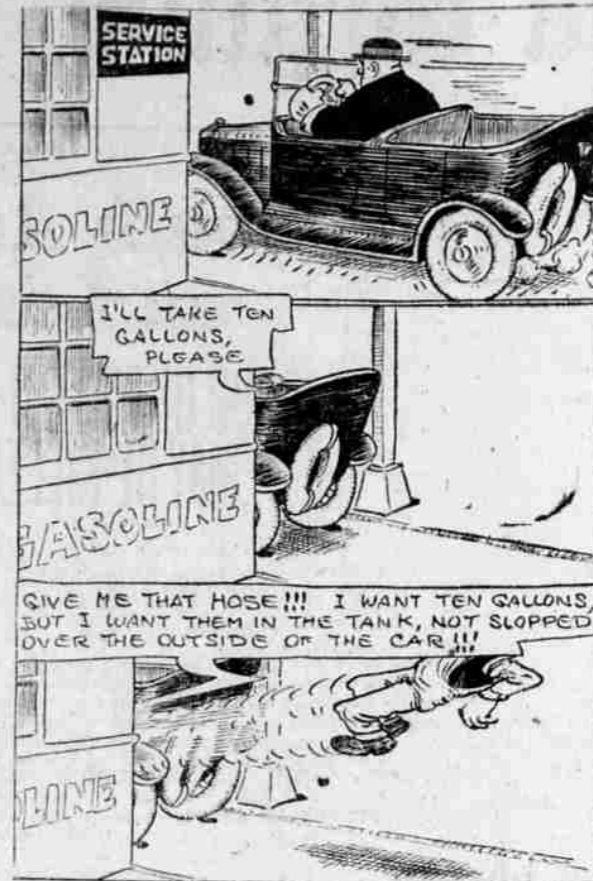

## NEW BUSINESS IS ESTABLISHED

George Young Opens Candy Store in J. G. Holm Grocery; is Practical Candy Maker.

George Young has come back into the candy-making business. He has been selling automobiles for the past several years and before that he spent eight years with the Palace Confectionery where he was employed in the manufacturing end, being a practical candy-maker of life-long experience.

Mr. Young's new place of business is located on Adams avenue in the store room occupied by the Holm grocery. A room 24 by 30 feet has been partitioned off for Mr. Young's use and a portion of the mezzanine floor has been fitted up for the use of the manufacturing end of the business.

A soda fountain will be installed and booths will be built. The candy store is to be partitioned off from the grocery store with lattice work painted white. In order to be able to keep the candy store open at night and shut the grocery store off and still use the main entrance, an iron folding gate will be installed.

Three girls will be employed. Later it is possible that Mr. Young will install his own ice cream plant.

Mr. Young will have charge of the manufacturing end himself, and will also devote part of his time to the retail department. He is the only practical candy-maker in the city having his own business.

He expects to give service and quality at a reasonable price.
