"THE WOMAN IN HIS HOUSE" A SCREEN MASTERPIECE

HOLMAN DAYS GREAT NORTH WOODS STORY FILMED

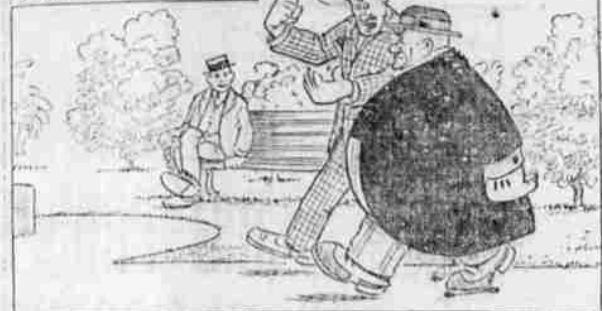

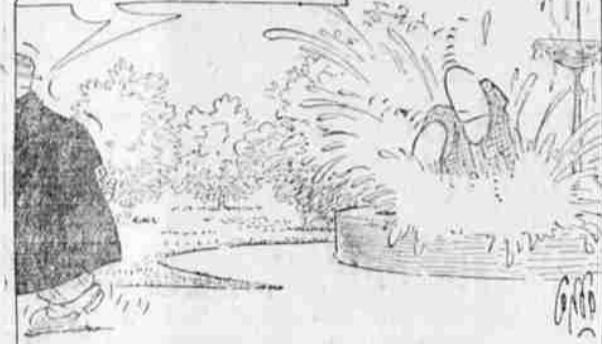

"Death" Crossing Where Boys Were Killed Almost Claims Another Victim

IMBLER PREACHER 2—IMBLER, Sept. 26—(Special)—Had he not jumped from his automobile this morning when crossing the railroad track at "Death," expiating in this city, it is very doubtful if Rev. D. W. Martin, pastor of the Imbler Methodist church, would be alive to tell the story.

He was crossing the railroad track on the ill-fated crossing where several boys were killed last summer when the O-W passenger train hit a truck loaded with youngsters, and did not see the approaching engine until it was almost upon him.

Rev. Martin instantly jumped from his car which just barely crossed the tracks as the engine pulled in. Neither himself nor the car was injured but the escape was a thrilling one.

People of Imbler today are setting up a petition to have some sort of signals established at "Death" crossing to prevent further accidents.

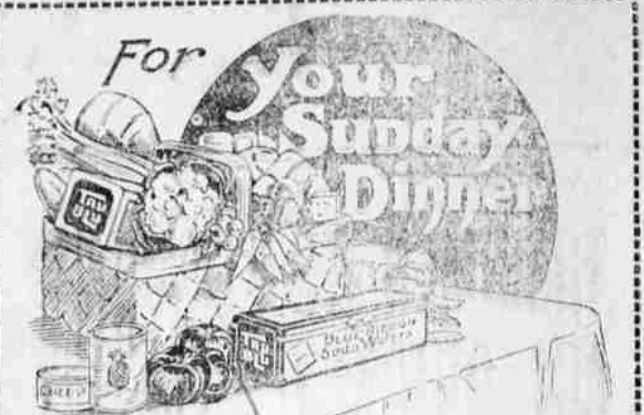

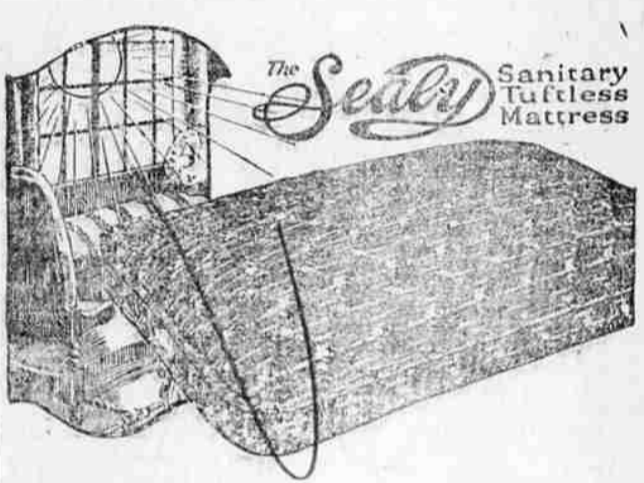
