FARMERS TO BUY AT WHOLESALE

Arrangements Made for the Purchasing of Farm Machinery at Exceptional Low Cost.

The latest coup of the farm bureau and grange organizations in Union county comes in arrangements just made with the Oregon Moline Plow Company and C. W. Banting & Son of this city whereby it will be possible for the members of both organizations in this county to buy wagons, machinery and farm equipment made by the Moline Company at the wholesale price plus the freight and 7 1/2 per cent as a handling charge. To obtain the benefit of this arrangement, all the purchaser needs to do is to present to C. W. Banting & Son a certificate showing that he is a member of either the Farm Bureau or Grange organization, in good standing and with all dues paid up.

Edwin Peck, manager of the Oregon Moline Plow Company, was the company's representative in putting over the deal. He has been associated with various companies for more than twenty years in the implement business and is familiar with every phase of the industry. Mr. Peck says that here, before nearly 50 per cent of the retail price of farm implements has been chargeable to the poor methods of marketing. Every big implement house has kept a force of high salaried salesmen on the road and must have a correspondingly large office force to handle the many details of their selling system. The new system of selling to farm organizations in a body through a local dealer will enable the reduction of these forces to the minimum. It is reasonable to assume that this new arrangement will increase the Moline company's volume of business, which will enable them to well afford giving the consumer the benefit of the entire saving in marketing costs.

The contract completed is similar to many others which are being signed by county farm bureaus and grange organizations all over the United States. It is looked upon with favor by the national heads of both organizations. It is also endorsed by the secretary of the Oregon State Farm Bureau Federation.

Members of the Executive Committee of both local organizations and many representative farmers who have investigated the contract, are very enthusiastic over the arrangement and feel that the Moline Plow Company has hit upon the right solution of machinery selling problems and is about two jumps ahead of any other similar company.

C. W. Banting & Son have been appointed distributors for Union county and are now in position to quote next year's prices for spring delivery.

AUTO THEFTS HAVE DECREASED

ST. LOUIS, Mo., Oct. 20.—Despite a 20 per cent increase in the number of automobiles, thefts of automobiles decreased 10 per cent in 1920 as compared with 1919, according to statistics made public at headquarters of the National Automobile Dealers' Association here.

The association attributed the decline to results obtained from the federal motor vehicle theft law, more stringent laws in various states for the punishment of automobile thieves and vigorous police activity.
