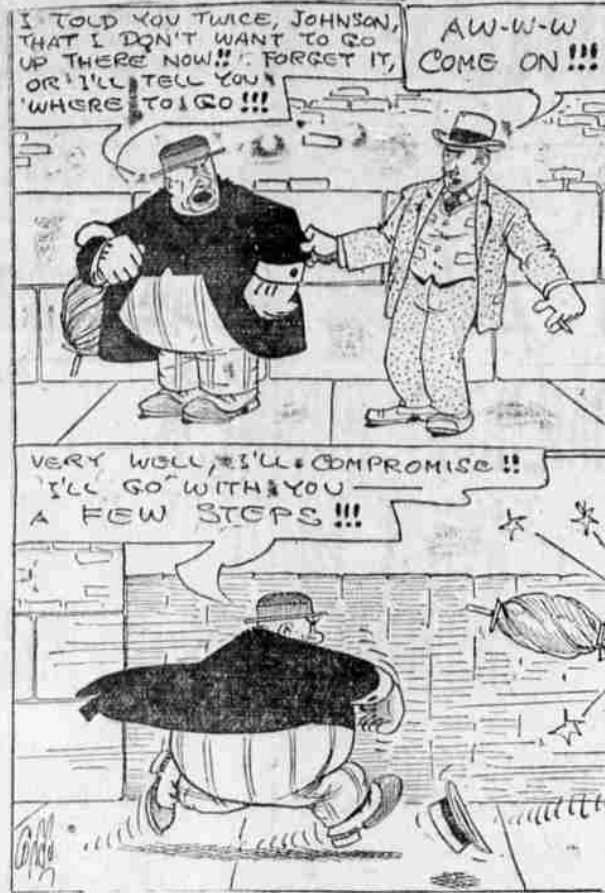

ELGIN, Oct. 21.—(Special)—The Farmers Union meeting held at the Farmers Union Hall in Elgin last Saturday was attended by a representative county membership. Mr. and Mrs. H. On account of the train service, it was decided to hold the next county meeting here on the second Saturday in January. In the afternoon various matters were discussed that were of interest to the county in general. Dinner was served by the Elgin Union.

Bert Higgins and Joe Hardy left a few days ago on a deer hunt at Chicken Springs, near the head of the Minam. This is held to be the hunting ground par excellence for this game. They expect to stay 'til they get the game.

On Tuesday night a reception was tendered the teachers of the Elgin schools by the Women's club. A program consisting of an address of welcome by L. ### SUPER SHIP TO BE LAUNCHED

#### Japan Has Monster Fighting Machine Ready to Put in Water.

TOKIO, Oct. 20.—The superdreadnought Mutsu, sister ship of the Nagato and the second capital ship to be completed under the eight-eight program, will be placed in commission by the Japanese navy on December 1 and will then become one of the capital ships of the first squadron, together with the Nagato and the Yamashiro. The Mutsu has a displacement of 23,200 tons. The third capital ship under the eight-eight program, the Kaga, is expected to be launched at the Kawasaki Dockyard in Kobe in December, this

year, and to be completed in November, 1922. The work on the Kaga has been delayed for some weeks owing to the recent shipyard strikes in Kobe. This superdreadnought will have a displacement of 49,000 tons.

All the new Japanese ships are equipped with 16-inch guns. The Mutsu and Nagato carry eight of these monster guns apiece, and it is possible that the Kaga will carry twelve.

### RES MAKE RED THREATS AGAINST U. S. CONSULATE

PARIS, Oct. 21.—Retaliatory measures in event of the execution of two Italians, Sacco and Vanzetti, convicted of murder in Massachusetts, are threatened against the American consulates in Paris, Bordeaux, Lyons and Marseilles, in letters received at those consulates today and signed by communist organizations.
