He was plowing a field, saw some geese and got his gun. While climbing a fence, his gun was discharged. Coroner Richardson will hold no inquest.

WOMAN DRIVER FINED; LICENSE IS SUSPENDED

PORTLAND, Oct. 22.—Mrs. E. E. Pines, driver of an automobile which collided with a motorcycle driven by Bert Campbell at East Fifty-fourth street and Sandy boulevard, September 28, from the result of which Campbell died, was fined \$50 and her driving license revoked for nine months by Judge George Rosman yesterday, on a charge of reckless driving. The coroner's jury recommended that the grand jury investigate the case, but thus far that body has made no report.

ARBuckle HAS MORE PARTIES, SAYS BRADY

LOS ANGELES, Oct. 22.—There was much comment here today, especially in the motion picture colony, regarding the declaration of District Attorney Matthew Brady of San Francisco that he has obtained evidence here to show that Roscoe "Fatty" Arbuckle has had at least one "big party" in Los Angeles, and possibly two, since his release from the San Francisco jail.

RATS KILLED BY THOUSANDS.

PARIS, Oct. 22.—More than 570,114 rats have been killed in Paris since the offensive against them was started a year ago. Bonuses have been paid at the rate of 30 centimes a head. In the first month of the campaign the bonus was paid upon delivery by the rat hunter of the tail of the animal but a sewer cleaner became an ex-

pert in the art of manufacturing rat tails out of leather and other material at the rate of several hundreds per day and since then the bonus has been "per head" instead of "per tail."
