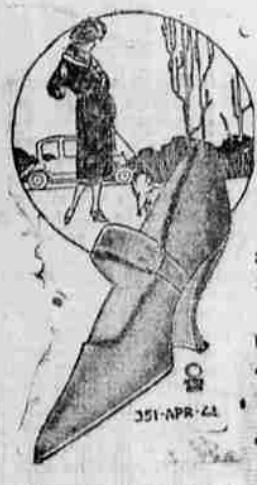

on the other. Due to a railroad strike in Vienna, no trains are running and I am again on a boat going back to Belgrade and will now finish your letter. The boat is crowded with people and luggage. The weather is still fine and last night I snuggled up in my fur coat and slept all night on deck and this morning I feel like a million dollars. I'd feel like two million if I could have had coffee for breakfast instead of tea, which was all they served. All the bridges over the Danube, between Austria and Hungary are under guard and passage over them is cut off by lots of barb wire, so evidently there is trouble ahead. They say they fear a revolution in Hungary, and Serbia is having trouble with Communists and is now in bad with the Allies over her actions on the Albanian border, so the cock-tail of Europe does not as yet seem to have arrived at the peace state. The custom officers are already going over our boat, although we aren't due to land for hours, and I hear them ever objecting to Hungarian newspapers.

"Some day traveling may again be simple over here, but at present it is beset with many difficulties: one must go to the police within twenty-four hours after arrival and again to secure permission to leave, and its visit every time you turn around, and much inspection of baggage. On either side as we sail down stream, we are passing wooden floating structures, which have huge wooden wheels on the side, these are their flour mills and after seeing how much 'brod' every one devalues in this country, you are not surprised that they need so many mills. Crops were poor in Serbia this year so their 'dinar' has not increased in value. I suppose you are wondering what my plans are; I sincerely know myself. I have been offered the superintendency of the hospital at Veles, but every one there is not only sick but very unhappy in the home life, so I said no. I can go to Northern Serbia with the Serbian relief, also into Russia and Poland and there is also private work to be had in Paris, but as yet I can't say definitely. Just as soon as I decide will let you know.

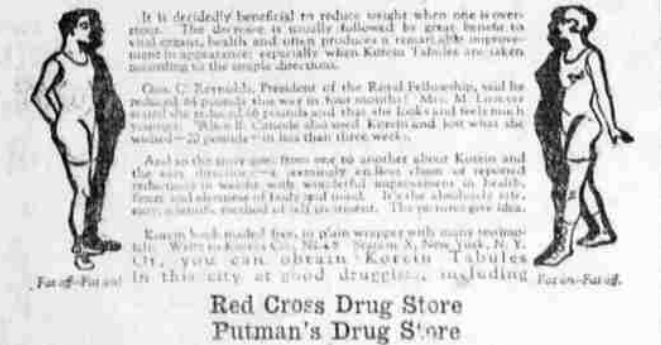
SISTER WRITES FROM AUSTRIA

Miss Bess Cameron Tells of Conditions in Country Where Princes are Being used for Fairs now.

eron, who is now in Austria and tells of conditions in that country:
"Vienna, Austria, Sept. 22, 1921
"My Dear Family: Ever since we turned over our hospital to the Serbs and left behind us the uninteresting town of Pristina, I've been hoping to write to you; and now while sitting in one of the most beautiful spots I have ever seen, I'll make the attempt. Am now seeing the loveliness of Schoenbrunn, the palace and gardens of the kings and queens of the Hapsburgs. Their personal glory is now but a thing of memory, but the glory of their past possessions can now be shared by both Patriotic and peasant alike "and no man in all the country, but is heir of

the earldom as much as they! There are many such palaces in and around Vienna, all very plain as to exteriors but containing many wonderful treasures, especially pictures, many of which are now for sale, remarkably cheap. An international exhibit of manufactures is being held here now in the various palaces of the former monarchs, while the grounds are all public parks. They have such an attractive style of horticulture here that of trimming the trees so they present a high straight green wall effect, and one can look down these long green lanes, and see the most attractive fountains and statues. They seem to combine the stolidness and strength of the German architecture with the artistic beauty of the French style here, most successfully, and oh, how I've enjoyed walking once again on clean asphalt sidewalks and roads, after the cobbles and mud of Serbia. Conditions are still unsettled in Austria and living is very difficult for the native as speculation in money is being carried on and the crown is very low in value. You can get some idea when I tell you that before the war five crowns (Austrian) made an American dollar, and in the three weeks I've been here, I've gotten all the way from 1200 to 1800 for each American dollar.

"Shops are full of splendid, attractive values, and so very cheap, that it made one wild to buy many things. There are daily riots at their houses or wall street, over the exchange, but even so, everyone seems to be fairly prosperous; and operas, theatres and expensive restaurants are always overflowing, and if necessary they might easily dispose of some of their art treasures, in order to feed the poor, and I'm sure there is as much need in our own country for relief dollars as in Vienna.
"I was so fortunate in accidentally running into an old friend, a Chicago Presbyterian nurse, who is in charge of Red Cross work here I went around with her a great deal in the auto and saw many interesting things I would not otherwise have seen. The Hapsburg people are still in Vienna, but will pull out in the spring. It's a delightful city in every respect and I think I rather like the Austrians. You would have enjoyed the opera Ida, it is supposed to be the finest in Europe and having sung in Vienna opera gives a singer an entrance anywhere in the world. I heard Faust, Lohengrin and the "City of the Dead," from box seats at a dollar per seat—that could never be done at home.
"After we left Pristina, we spent a few days in Belgrade, then journeyed by boat up the Danube for three days and two nights. "Twas a delightful trip and I shall never hear Strauss' "Blue Danube" waltz without living it all over. Each side of the river was lined with neat tiny villages and the foliage all aflame with autumnal colors. The stream passes through Serbian, Czechoslovakian, Hungarian and Austrian territory and the capital of Hungary lies on both sides—the town Buda on one side and the town Pest
