Hall Young, who first came to Alaska as a missionary about fifty years ago, has been named general missionary for the northern territory for the Presbyterian Church and will make his home once again in the northland. Often called a "living history of Alaska" because of his wide knowledge of the northland, Dr. Young wrote recently that he is glad he is spending his remaining days in the territory. Years ago he accompanied John Muir on several Alaska tours and has written several books on Alaska. He has been in every gold stampede in the north, it is said, including the famous rush to the Klondike in 1898.

Dr. Young succeeds Dr. J. H. Condit as general missionary. Dr. Condit having been named head of the Sheldon Jackson School at Sitka, Alaska. As general missionary Dr. Young will have charge of all Presbyterian missions in the territory. Before com-
