It is interpreted as not giving definite acceptance to the American ratio proposals regarding capital ships.

GOVERNMENT SELLS HOUSES

(By Associated Press) BRISTOL, Pa., Dec. 20.—The 320 houses built by the government during the war at Harriman to accommodate shipyard workers Saturday were disposed of at auction for \$772,245. The average cost of erection was about \$5,000, although the highest bid Saturday was \$5700. The lowest prices was \$1300. The total cost of the project to the government was estimated at \$16,674,785.

VIOLATORS ARRESTED

(By Associated Press) CHICAGO, Dec. 20.—More than 500 persons are under arrest here charged with violation of the prohibition laws. The prisoners are being held at various police stations. Chief Fitzmorris said that plans for further arrests were under way. The arrests were made last night and today in raids conducted by the police at the order of the chief of police, who has promised to "make Chicago so dry that it squeaks."

Among the places raided was the exclusive Casino club, which numbers among its members many society folks. One man who, the police said, was found with a bottle of liquor in his hand was arrested.
