Irrigation is no right nor the paramount need of the whole country, many believe, assuming that the vast Sandridge wheat belt is included. But close observers of Union county's needs earnestly believe that water rightfully applied on the tremendous district of fringed land connecting the foothills with the main floor of the valley, can be made garden spots, possessed of wealth by the application of water, the institution of small-herd dairying, and general application of the small-tract farm principles. It is doubtful if the big wheat belts will be cut up now, or in the near future--some day they will be and then watch Union county grow. But right now--the coming summer--scores of small farmers around the fringes of the valley are ready for water, their owners schooled in small farm methods and ready to milk a few cows every morning and night.

But the demand of the moment is the first step that will bring water. Every other section of arid and semi-arid Oregon has planned its first step, and last Union county, by years behind the new era in Oregon that is dawning now, she must soon take her first step toward extensive irrigation of certain sections of her land. Every month of delay spells that many months trailing the procession of advancement in Oregon.
