Income Tax Man to Be Here an Entire Week During March

Announcement has been made by Clyde M. Huntley, collector of internal revenue at Portland, that from March 2 to March 9, inclusive, H. O. Payne, of the internal revenue office, will be in La Grande, with headquarters in the civil service room of the postoffice, for the purpose of assisting taxpayers in Union county in making out their income tax returns. The deputy collector will give any information desired by taxpayers in regard to making out their returns when he is in La Grande. The last day for filing the reports for 1921 is March 15, and all who fail to file them on or before that date are subject to heavy penalties. The announcement, posted in the postoffice recently, that Mr. Payne would have his headquarters in the court house is erroneous, he declared when he was here Saturday.

Ice Houses Filled At North Powder

NORTH POWDER, Jan. 30.—The work of putting up ice for the P. E. Co. was completed Tuesday. Ninety-seven men were employed in the task. A total of 19,000 tons of ice were stored in the company's big storage plant at this point and 7,500 tons were shipped to Umatilla, Huntington, La Grande, Oregon, and Tekoa, Washington, for the company's use. Mr. White, superintendent, estimates that about 11,000 tons of ice will go to waste on the ponds. The thickness of the ice reached 15 inches and the quality was better than usual.
