# The Screen

## AT SHERRY THEATRE SUNDAY AND MONDAY

"Camille," the Nazimova production for Metro Pictures Corporation, is the inimitable Russian star's modernized version of the famous story of Alexander Dumas, the younger.

This story, famed throughout the civilized world as a masterpiece of love and sacrifice, was the first play written by the younger Dumas and was done when he was little over twenty years of age. He is said to have written it in eight days. His father pronounced it a masterpiece—but it was denied production by managers because of its unusual character.

The censors interdicted it. So in seven days the author turned it into a novel, in which form it was published, making its appearance just before the Revolution of 1848.

Four years later, on February 2, 1852, it was put on the Vaudeville Theatre at Paris through the influence of the Duc de Morny and its unusual theme won it instant attention. By now critics it is regarded as the prototype of the modern "problem" play. Since then it has been one of the favorites, revival after revival demonstrating the vogue it still enjoys despite its age. Its strong emotional scenes have won the historic support of many notable actresses who have listed it among their repertoire of theatrical offerings. It has enjoyed equal popularity in this country, England, France and Germany, where the theatregoers have warmly welcomed it both in adaptations and in the original French.

Rudolph Valentino, famous for his performance in "The Four Horsemen" supports Nazimova.
