BOOSTING FOR U. S. SHIPPING

BUDAPEST, Feb. 20.—U. Grant Smith the United States Charge d'Affaires in Hungary is making representations to the Hungarian Government that the United States Shipping Board's lines should be included among the licensed shipping companies. Before the war, Hungary exercised a preferential treatment by which almost all emigration traffic was in the hands of the Cuffard line and attempts to restore this policy have been made since the war.

Frank E. Ferris, of the United States Shipping Board, who was here some days ago, had a long discussion on the subject with members of the government, and it is expected that equal treatment will be secured for the United States lines in the near future.

PARDON RIGHT IS ATTACKED

(By Associated Press)
BUENOS AIRES, Feb. 20.—A ponderous legal controversy has arisen between President Irigoyen and the courts over the president's right to pardon a boy who had been sentenced to serve two years in the penitentiary for stealing a dozen pairs of cotton socks.

Jose Ibanez, the 19-year-old youth, who was employed in a Buenos Aires clothing store, did not steal the socks for himself, but for a poor boy who had none. Nevertheless, the judge gave him the full penalty of the law.

Appeal was taken to the criminal court of appeals and Jose was kept in jail for 11 months while the judges deliberated. President Irigoyen intervened and pardoned him, and Jose returned to his home.

The court then ordered the police to arrest him and return him to prison, asserting the president had no power to pardon a person whose guilt or innocence had not

been legally determined. They said as Jose had not been convicted pending their decision, he could not be pardoned. However, the usually efficient Buenos Aires police have thus far failed to locate the boy claimed by the court as a fugitive from justice. Meantime the Appellate judges and the minister of justice are engaged in a lively debate as to the constitutional argu, prints seven columns quoting precedents and authorities including those of American jurists in support of the President.
