Basanta Singh, the Hindu wrestler, who has been wrestling on the Pacific Coast for several years, has never been beaten by a man of his weight, which is around 160 pounds. About two years ago he wrestled a two-hour five minute draw with Ted Tye, after losing to Ted two months before in two straight falls. Both Gustavo and Singh defeated Hackensmidt. Singh won the first fall in eighteen minutes with a toe hold and Hackensmidt failed to re-appear, conceding Singh the match. The genial Hindu is expecting to win, but, like his opponent, he expects to have a hard tussle. He appears to be in first class shape. He is accompanied by his trainer, Eddie Loven, of Pendleton.

Both men are of about the same weight, within a few pounds, and both are clean, aggressive wrestlers. Preliminary to the main event, O. D. Scott, local wrestler, will meet Frankie La Rose, a boxer, in a mixed match. This will be the first event of its kind ever staged in La Grande.
