Building Boom Has Struck La Grande; Many Homes Planned

peract. Several of these houses have already been begun.

Read's home will be a five-room modern colonial bungalow and G. R. Claydon, Harry Levy, Oscar Johnson and E. J. Latta are erecting homes on a similar plan, all being executive men. W. R. Jones will erect two five-room bungalows. James Gayler, Jr., will build a modern home in back of his father's home on 9th avenue.

C. R. Baell, Nels Nelson and Norman Freen, are among those who are also planning on building. Percy Blanchard, it is reported, will build three houses this spring.

Those mentioned as planning new homes are only a small number of the La Grande people who have decided to build their own homes this year. Architecturally most of the homes will be of five and six room bungalow type and the costs will range from \$3,000 to \$5,000, although many will cost more and some less expensive homes are being built. The highest share of the bungalows will cost between \$3500 and \$4000.

The building permit record in the city recorder's office shows that much repair work as well as new work is being done. During the past few days the following permits have been issued for repair work that will run over \$1,000 for each permit, while a great number of permits for smaller repair jobs have been issued: W. G. Sawyer, Spring street, between Second and Fourth, \$1,500; La Grande Investment company, Depot and Adams, \$1,250. Among the permits for dwelling houses issued the past several days are the following: J. A. Campbell, Y avenue between Ash and Fourth, \$2,000; Mrs. P. L. Thornton, Jefferson between Greenwood and Henlock, \$1,200; Wm. Hollins, K between Twelfth and Thirteenth streets, \$1,200; Walter Whitman, X between Depot and Birch, \$1,500.

Dwelling houses are not the only portion of the huge building program that has been started. The Foley hotel remodeling will be one of the biggest jobs of this kind to be undertaken this year. The Wade Brothers Oil company is erecting a modern filling station at the corner of Adams and Greenwood. Stiles and Ellidge are building a warehouse on Greenwood between Madison and Jefferson. The La Grande Construction company is greatly enlarging its factory at the corner of Greenwood and Madison, the plans including the erection of a new brick building and the installation of much new, modern machinery to take care of the heavy demands made for wash and doors by the building being done this year.
