SCUTARI, Albania, Apr. 19.—Calendars and clocks are luxuries in Albania. The untutored peasantry know only three periods of time—morning, noon and night, and two seasons of the year, winter and summer. Days and dates are Sanskrit to them. Nor have they any conception of distances. When a traveler asks an Albanian the distance of one point from another, he never answers in miles or kilometers but "It is half a day, it is two days, it is a week." When an Albanian makes an appointment, he is considered to have kept it if he comes within two or three hours of the time set.

With the absence of calendars, the people naturally do not know their correct ages, especially those in the country districts. In this respect the women of Albania enjoy an advantage over their sisters in foreign countries who guard jealously the secret of their years. Often the age of an Albanian woman is unknown even to herself.
